

Maintaining Stainless Steel

- Start by mixing a solution of 1 teaspoon dish detergent and 1 quart hot tap water (wear gloves to protect your hands from the heat).
- Using a microfiber cloth, rub the detergent solution onto any marks in small sections (it will take a little elbow grease), going in the direction of the grain.
- Rinse with clean, hot water only, and dry immediately with a clean cloth.
- You may also try buffing away streaks with mineral oil, or using a special stainless steel cleaner.
