

Maintaining Cabinets

- Dust Frequently using a soft, cotton cloth
- Spills and spots should be removed immediately with a lightly dampened, soft cloth.
Use a small amount of mild detergent diluted with water if necessary. Follow by wiping with a dry cloth. Detergents with citrus or ammonia are not recommended
- You may polish once every few months with non-oil based furniture polish.
AVIOD: any polish containing silicone as well as paste waxes
- Glass inserts can be cleaned with regular window cleaner and a soft cloth.
